What are you doing about the addiction crisis in your community?

- 20.2 million adults — 8.5 percent of the U.S. population — need treatment for an illicit drug or alcohol use problem. Only 18.5 percent of those addicted received treatment according to the most recent National Survey on Drug Use and Health report.
- Over 200 people die daily from alcohol or drug addiction.
- Of the 20.2 million adults with a substance abuse disorder in the past year, 7.9 million also had a mental illness.

Program Goal

To reduce a patient's addiction symptoms and improve their overall health and functioning.

Features

Patients Served: Adults age 18 and older with a primary substance use disorder. Patient may have a comorbid mental health disorder.

Services provided:

- Comprehensive assessment & consultation
- Individualized treatment planning
- Psychotherapy/Family therapy
- Toxicology screening
- Intensive case management
- Referral and care coordination with medical providers
- Referral to psychiatrist or psychiatric extender

Program Schedule: Group therapy 4 days a week, 3 hours a day, 12 hours a week. Families and significant others are invited to participate one evening per week.
